

Court Response Scripts for Special Divine Appearance

Quick Reference Guide for Living Man/Woman in South African Courts

OPENING STATEMENT SCRIPT

When Your Name is Called:

"Your Honor, I must respectfully correct the record before we proceed. I am [Your Full Name], a living man/woman of flesh and blood, created in the image of the Divine. I appear here today by Special Divine Appearance only, under natural law, constitutional law, and international law.

The document before this court appears to be directed to a legal fiction - a corporate entity written in ALL CAPITAL LETTERS. I am not that fiction. I am a living being with inherent, inalienable rights that predate any government or corporation.

I do not consent to any presumption of jurisdiction over my person, and I reserve all rights without prejudice. From this moment, I invoke the transformation of these proceedings from a corporate court to a Constitutional Tribunal operating under the supreme law of our land."

JURISDICTION CHALLENGE SCRIPTS

When Judge Claims Jurisdiction:

"Your Honor, I respectfully challenge the jurisdiction of this court on constitutional grounds. This court operates under the authority of an entity registered as 'REPUBLIC

OF SOUTH AFRICA' (CIK: 0000932419) - a foreign corporation registered in Washington DC.

Under Section 39(1)(b) of our Constitution, international law must be considered. Under international law, no living being can be subject to corporate jurisdiction without explicit consent. I have never consented to be governed by a foreign corporation or to surrender my constitutional rights.

I demand proof that this court has lawful authority over living beings rather than corporate fictions."

When Asked About Legal Representation:

"Your Honor, I represent myself as a living man/woman exercising my constitutional right under Section 34 to access the courts. I do not require legal representation as I am not engaging in legal fiction. I am here in my natural capacity, speaking plain English, not legalese.

If the court insists on legal representation, it would be admitting that these proceedings are designed for corporate fictions rather than living beings, which would violate my constitutional rights."



RESPONSE TO COMMON COURT QUESTIONS

"Do you understand the charges?"

"Your Honor, I understand that charges have been brought against a legal fiction that shares a similar name to mine. However, I am not that fiction. I am a living man/woman, and I do not consent to being treated as a corporate entity.

If you are asking whether I comprehend the English language, yes, I do. If you are asking whether I 'stand under' the authority of this court, I do not, as I have not consented to such authority."

"How do you plead?"

"Your Honor, I cannot enter a plea to charges brought against a legal fiction. I am not the entity named in these proceedings. However, if this tribunal wishes to proceed against me as a living being, I invoke my constitutional right to due process and demand:

1. Proof that I have committed a crime against another living being
2. Evidence of actual harm or injury to a real person
3. Demonstration that this court has jurisdiction over living beings
4. Verification that all parties have standing as living beings rather than corporate fictions"

"Are you [LEGAL NAME]?"

"Your Honor, I am [Your Full Name], a living man/woman. The name you have referenced appears to be a corporate fiction written in ALL CAPITAL LETTERS, which under legal convention represents a dead entity or corporation. I am very much alive, as evidenced by my breathing, my warm blood, and my presence here today.

I do not consent to being identified with any corporate fiction, trust, or legal entity created without my knowledge or consent."

DEFENSIVE RESPONSES

When Threatened with Contempt:

"Your Honor, I am showing the utmost respect for this tribunal by upholding the Constitution, which is the supreme law of our Republic. Any attempt to hold me in contempt for asserting my constitutional rights would itself be contemptuous of the Constitution.

Under Section 2 of the Constitution, any law or conduct inconsistent with the Constitution is invalid. I am exercising my constitutional duty to ensure these proceedings comply with the supreme law.

I invoke Section 12 of the Constitution - my right to freedom and security of person - and Section 35 - my rights if arrested or detained. Any violation of these rights would constitute a criminal offense."

When Judge Refuses to Acknowledge Arguments:

"Your Honor, your refusal to acknowledge my constitutional rights creates a constitutional crisis. Under Section 8(1) of the Constitution, the Bill of Rights binds all organs of state, including this court.

Under Section 172(1)(a), any court may declare law or conduct inconsistent with the Constitution invalid. I hereby invoke this provision and demand that these proceedings comply with constitutional requirements.

I also invoke Section 38 - my right to approach a court for constitutional relief - and reserve the right to seek immediate intervention from the Constitutional Court."

When Ordered to Sit Down or Be Quiet:

"Your Honor, I am exercising my constitutional right under Section 16 - freedom of expression - and Section 34 - right to a fair hearing. These rights cannot be arbitrarily limited.

Under Section 36, rights may only be limited by law of general application, and any limitation must be reasonable and justifiable. Silencing my constitutional arguments would be neither reasonable nor justifiable.

I respectfully maintain my right to speak in defense of the Constitution and my inherent rights as a living being."

PROCEDURAL CHALLENGES

When Court Tries to Proceed Without Consent:

"Your Honor, I object to these proceedings continuing without my consent. Under natural law and constitutional law, no authority may be exercised over a living being

without their consent.

I invoke the principle of 'nemo dat quod non habet' - no one can give what they do not have. This court cannot exercise authority it does not lawfully possess.

I demand that these proceedings be stayed until proper jurisdiction is established and my constitutional rights are fully protected."

When Asked to Take an Oath:

"Your Honor, I will affirm to tell the truth, as I am bound by divine law and natural law to speak truthfully. However, I will not take an oath that might be construed as consent to this court's jurisdiction or as acknowledgment of the legal fiction named in these proceedings.

I affirm that I will speak truthfully in my capacity as a living man/woman, under penalty of perjury, and in the presence of the Divine."

When Documents are Presented:

"Your Honor, before I can respond to any documents, I must examine them to determine:

1. Whether they are directed to me as a living being or to a legal fiction
2. Whether they comply with constitutional requirements
3. Whether they are based on lawful authority
4. Whether they respect my inherent rights

I reserve the right to challenge any document that violates my constitutional rights or attempts to treat me as a corporate fiction."

OFFENSIVE STRATEGIES

Demanding Proof of Authority:

"Your Honor, before these proceedings continue, I demand that you provide proof of your authority:

- 1. Do you receive funding from the foreign corporation registered as 'REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA'?**
- 2. Have you taken an oath to uphold the Constitution or to serve corporate interests?**
- 3. Can you demonstrate that you have jurisdiction over living beings rather than corporate fictions?**
- 4. Will you confirm that you are operating under constitutional law rather than commercial law?**

Your answers will determine whether this is a lawful tribunal or an unlawful commercial proceeding."

Challenging Plaintiff's Standing:

"Your Honor, I challenge the standing of the plaintiff in these proceedings:

- 1. Is the plaintiff a living being or a corporate fiction?**
- 2. If representing an institution, can they prove lawful authority over living people?**
- 3. Can they demonstrate actual harm or injury to a real person?**
- 4. Are they engaged in trafficking of human beings or slavery, which would be criminal?**

Without proper standing, these proceedings cannot lawfully continue."

Invoking Tribune Status:

"Your Honor, I invoke my status as Tribune of the Plebs, recognized under Section 39(1) (c) of our Constitution, which allows consideration of foreign law including Roman law precedents.

As Tribune, I have the authority to:

- 1. Intercede on behalf of living people against corporate oppression**
- 2. Veto any action that violates natural law or constitutional rights**
- 3. Demand protection from unlawful authority**
- 4. Order investigation of corporate crimes against the people**

Any violation of my tribune status carries severe penalties under natural law."



EMERGENCY RESPONSES

If Threatened with Arrest:

"Your Honor, any attempt to arrest me for exercising my constitutional rights would constitute:

- 1. Violation of Section 12 - Freedom and security of person**
- 2. Unlawful detention under common law**
- 3. Kidnapping under criminal law**
- 4. Crimes against humanity under international law**

I invoke immediate constitutional protection and international intervention. All parties are warned of their personal liability for any unlawful actions."

If Court Becomes Hostile:

"Your Honor, I note for the record that this tribunal is becoming hostile to constitutional rights and due process. I invoke:

- 1. Section 34 - Right to fair hearing**
- 2. Section 35 - Rights of accused persons**
- 3. International protection under the ICCPR**
- 4. Emergency intervention under natural law**

I reserve all rights to seek immediate relief and to hold all parties personally liable for constitutional violations."

If Forced to Leave:

"Your Honor, I am being forced to leave under protest. Let the record show that:

- 1. I have not consented to these proceedings**
- 2. My constitutional rights have been violated**

3. This court has failed to establish lawful jurisdiction
4. These proceedings are null and void for lack of due process

I reserve all rights to seek constitutional relief and international intervention."



KEY PHRASES TO REMEMBER

Essential Declarations:

- "I appear by Special Divine Appearance only"

Powerful Challenges:

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FINAL STRATEGY NOTES

Maintain Throughout:

1. **Calm, respectful demeanor** - Never become aggressive
2. **Constitutional authority** - Always cite legal basis
3. **Living being status** - Constantly distinguish from fiction
4. **Reserved rights** - Never waive or surrender anything
5. **Record everything** - Document all violations

Never Say:

- "I understand" (implies standing under authority)
- "I am [LEGAL NAME]" (accepts fictional identity)
- "I consent" (waives rights)
- "I submit" (accepts jurisdiction)
- "I plead" (acknowledges charges against fiction)

Always Remember:

- **You are sovereign** - Act with authority
- **Constitution is supreme** - No law can override it
- **Rights are inherent** - Not granted by government
- **Consent is required** - For any lawful authority

- **Truth will prevail** - Stand firm in your position
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"The Constitution is not a grant of power to government, but a limitation upon government power in favor of individual rights."
